 2. 3. 	Purchase Price. The full purchase price of \$ is agreed with the balance due in full at least week(s) before the puppy/dog is delivered to the Buyer or upon Buyer's pickup of the puppy/dog. The Buyer will be invoiced and will make payments through the secure QuickBooks site online using a credit card, debit card or bank draft, or the Buyer may pay in cash if the dog is picked up in person. Microchip Enrollment. The puppy/dog's microchip must be enrolled with AKC Reunite by the Buyer at the Buyer's expense before the puppy/dog leaves the breeder's possession. The Breeder will provide the Buyer with the puppy/dog's microchip number and instructions for enrolling the puppy/dog. Transportation. Any shipping and handling expenses are the responsibility of the Buyer and shall be
4.	paid by the Buyer. Transportation will be by for \$ Full Registration. The puppy/dog is a purebred Pembroke Welsh Corgi registerable/ registeredwith
	AKC and is being sold with Full AKC registration which allows show and breeding rights on the puppy/dog. The Breeder agrees to provide the Buyer with all registration papers.
5.	Registration of the puppy/dog. The Breeder agrees to provide the Buyer with the registration application for the puppy/dog or prepaid registration for the puppy/dog. If prepaid registration is offered, the Buyer agrees to provide the Breeder with a name for the puppy/dog starting with the Breeders kennel name "Harman Corgis" within 30 days after taking possession of the puppy/dog.

6. **Breeder's Obligations.** The Breeder represents and warrants the following.

- a. <u>Ownership.</u> The Breeder is the lawful owner of the puppy/dog and has the right to transfer ownership of the puppy/dog to the Buyer. Ownership of the puppy/dog will be transferred to the Buyer upon payment of the full purchase price.
- b. State of Health: Short term health warranty. The puppy/dog (i) was previously examined by a licensed veterinarian and was found to be in good health at that time and (ii) has had the vaccinations and parasite control listed on the health records provided to the Buyer. At the time the puppy/dog leaves the Breeders possession it will have been immunized with at least the following vaccinations: Canine Distemper, Adenovirus Type 1 (Hepatitis), Adenovirus Type 2 (Respiratory Disease), Parainfluenza, Parvovirus, and Bordetella and routinely wormed with Pyrantel and Safeguard and will be in good health to the best of the Breeders knowledge. The Buyer, at their own expense, must have the puppy/dog examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours (the Examination Period) after receiving the puppy/dog to have the puppy/dog checked for general health. The buyer must complete standard puppy vaccinations and deworming. If the buyer fails to have a veterinarian check performed within 72 hours after receiving the puppy or fails to continue puppy vaccinations, the guarantee shall be considered null and void. If within the Examination Period, the Buyer's veterinarian finds the puppy/dog to have a serious or chronic health issue or in poor general condition making it unfit for sale, the veterinarian must provide a written statement which must be sent to the Breeder within 48 hours of the veterinary examination. The Breeder reserves the right to a second opinion by a veterinarian of the Breeder's choice. If justifiable by both vets, the puppy/dog may (a) be returned to the Breeder for a full refund of the Purchase Price or (b) return the puppy/dog and receive a replacement puppy of equal quality, price, and sex within a reasonable time period. The foregoing guarantee expressly excludes (x) any health issues caused by the Buyers ill-treatment, abuse or neglect, (y) any health issues that result from the puppy/dog's transportation from the Breeder to the Buyer and (z) all minor illnesses and health issues that are treatable, including respiratory infections, allergic reactions, stress colitis/diarrhea, internal or external parasites or contagious viruses (including canine parvovirus), UTI's, vaginitis or umbilical hernias. The Breeder is NOT responsible for any vet bills or expenses. If the puppy dies within the Examination Period, the Buyer will provide the Breeder with a veterinarian's diagnosis and cause of death at which time the purchase price will be refunded, or the puppy/dog will be replaced by a puppy of equal quality, price, and sex within a reasonable time period.
- c. Long Term Health warranty. The Breeder provides a 1-year warranty from the puppy/dog's date of birth against debilitating congenital conditions known to the breed including DM, EIC and WVD1 that can cause death or seriously impairs vital functions in the puppy making it unsuitable for a family pet. Breeder will not be responsible for any inaccuracies of any testing done for any condition of the puppy including testing for any debilitating congenital conditions known to the breed to include DM, EIC and VWD1. In the event that the puppy/dog exhibits symptoms of a suspected debilitating congenital condition, the Buyer must immediately inform the Breeder and supply all requested veterinary records to the Breeder. The Breeder reserves the right to a second opinion by a veterinarian of the Breeder's choice and may request and pay for genetic testing.
- d. <u>Returns/Refunds</u>. If it is determined by a licensed veterinarian that the puppy/dog (i) was "unfit for purchase" or (ii) has a genetic disorder that is identified within the warranty periods described above, the Buyer may (x) return the puppy/dog and receive a replacement puppy/dog of comparable quality and sex from an upcoming litter (y) return the puppy/dog and receive reimbursement of the original Purchase Price or (z) keep the puppy/dog and receive reimbursement for any veterinary expenses related to the illness (provided that such reimbursement will not exceed the Purchase Price amount). Should the puppy/dog be returned or exchanged according to the terms of this section, the Buyer shall be responsible for any and all transportation expenses, veterinarian charges, crate fees, and transportation fees.

- e. **No Other Warranties.** The Breeder cannot and does not guarantee the physical appearance or emotional disposition of the puppy/dog as it matures. The Breeder cannot guarantee size, color, eye color, bite, breeding ability or temperament. No other warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied, are made by the Breeder, and the puppy/dog is sold and delivered in an "as is" condition, except as expressly and specifically set forth herein.
- 7. **Buyer's Obligations.** The Buyer agrees to the following.
 - a. <u>Proper Care</u>. The Buyer will provide good and proper care of the puppy/dog. Such care includes adequate housing and protection from the elements, a safe (preferably fenced) exercise area or daily walks and exercise, and proper and sufficient nutrition and water. The Buyer will provide proper veterinary care throughout the puppy/dog's lifetime, including but not limited to, routine vaccinations and parasite control.
 - b. <u>Veterinary Care</u>. The Buyer will also provide veterinary care: (i) routine vaccinations, (ii) treatment for internal and external parasites (iii) annual examination by a licensed veterinarian.
 - c. Ensure that ears are both erect. The Buyer will contact the Breeder if the puppy/dog's ears do not stand up by 12 weeks of age and remain erect. Genetics and teething sometimes delay ears to stand up. In this case, the Buyer will be required to perform the painless procedure of "Taping" the puppy/dog's ears to help facilitate breed characteristics. The Breeder will provide instructions and guide the Buyer when this procedure is necessary.
 - d. <u>Care to prevent Orthopedic Conditions</u>. Orthopedic problems are caused by multiple factors including both genetic and environmental. To reduce the incidence of orthopedic problems, the Buyer will also provide the following care.
 - i. Proper nutrition to support ideal growth and maintain optimum body condition making sure that the puppy/dog is not overweight or underweight.
 - ii. Proper daily exercise to maintain that the puppy/dog is in good condition. Exercise should be age-appropriate to avoid stress injuries until growth plates have closed. Buyers will be provided with age-appropriate exercise guidelines from the Breeder.
 - iii. Avoidance of stress injuries such as not allowing the puppy/dog to jump from heights taller than itself at the shoulder. Corgis like all long-backed short-legged dogs, are prone to back injuries. Care should be taken to ensure that they are not allowed to jump from furniture or heights taller than their body height.
 - e. <u>Sale Prohibition</u>. The Buyer is not acting as an agent in the purchase of the puppy/dog. The Buyer agrees that the puppy/dog will not be sold by or through any commercial broker or wholesale establishment, chain store, catalog sales, or pet store. The buyer agrees that the puppy/dog will not be used for the purpose of vivisection or research.
 - f. Restrictions of Transfer. If at any time or for any reason during the pet's life (including upon Buyer's death or incapacity) the Buyer needs to find a new home for the dog, the Breeder will assist with finding the puppy/dog a new home or take it back rather than see it placed in a shelter. At the Breeders' sole election, the Buyer agrees that the puppy/dog shall be:
 - (a) returned to the Breeder together with duly executed documentation transferring Buyer's ownership interest in the puppy/dog to the Breeder at the sole expense of the Buyer, or
 - (b) rehomed by the Buyer with Breeder's prior written approval, in each case without any refunds or payments due to the Buyer.

Buyer agrees that under no circumstances may this puppy/dog at any age be relinquished to an animal shelter or rescue organization.

- g. **No transfer Outside of the United States.** The Buyer further agrees that the puppy/dog will not be sold to anyone residing outside of the United States without the Breeder's written approval.
- h. <u>Breach by Buyer.</u> The Buyer's breach of any of the foregoing obligations shall result in the Breeder's warranties set forth in this Agreement being null and void.
- 8. **Breeding Rights.** The Breeder acknowledges that the puppy/dog is being sold as a breeding prospect and represents that, at the time of sale, the puppy/dog shows promise of being worthy of being bred as an adult at the time of sale. The Breeder does not guarantee that the puppy/dog will be of breeding quality or is guaranteed to breed as an adult.

- Showing Rights. The Breeder acknowledges that the puppy/dog is being sold as a show prospect.
 The Breeder does not guarantee that the puppy/dog will be of show quality or how the puppy/dog
 will place in a show situation as an adult dog.
- 10. Remedy for mistreatment. If the Breeder learns or suspects that the puppy/dog is not getting proper care and treatment, Buyer agrees that the Breeder has the right to have the puppy/dog examined by a licensed veterinarian. If such veterinarian finds the puppy/dog to be a victim of ill-treatment, abuse, cruelty or neglect,
 - (a) the Breeder has the right to possession and ownership of the puppy/dog. Buyer agrees to transfer possession and ownership of the puppy/dog to Breeder and that all registration documents will be transferred into Breeder's name by Buyer. Buyer agrees that the transfer of the puppy/dog and registration documents is at the sole expense of Buyer, and Buyer also agrees to the terms of Paragraph 14 below.
 - (b) Buyer agrees that all warranties of the puppy/dog shall become null and void if there is a transfer of possession and ownership of the puppy/dog back to Breeder based on mistreatment of the puppy/dog as provided above.
- 11. **Ongoing Communications.** Both parties agree to promptly notify the other of any change of address, email, or phone number. The Buyer agrees to (a)maintain contact with the Breeder regarding the puppy/dog for at least one calendar year and to promptly reply as possible to inquiries about the puppy/dog from the Breeder; (b) inform the Breeder of any major illnesses in the puppy/dog throughout the puppy/dog's life, including, but not limited to, cancer, epilepsy, heart, eye or heart conditions, allergies, bleeding disorders or autoimmune disease, and behavior problems particularly fear, anxiety or aggression. The Buyer will, upon the natural or accidental death of the puppy/dog, promptly notify the Breeder of the particulars of the animal's death.
- 12. **Agreement to Mediate.** If a dispute arises out of or relates to this Agreement, or the alleged breach thereof, and if the dispute is not settled through negotiation, the parties agree to first try in good faith to settle the dispute by non-binding mediation prior to the filing of any suit. The parties agree that mediation can be accomplished remotely by Zoom or any other similar means at the election of Breeder. The parties further agree that if mediation fails and any suit is filed, all pre-trial matters and the trial of the case can be accomplished remotely by Zoom or any other similar means at the election of Breeder as the Court will allow.
- 13. **Governing Law.** In the event of any dispute, the parties mutually agree that the dispute will determined in Ochiltree County, Texas but if suit is filed, Breeder may elect to bring suit in another county of competent jurisdiction.
- 14. **Miscellaneous.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding the subject matter herein and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreements, negotiations, discussion, and understandings, written or oral, between the parties with respect to such subject matter. Neither party may assign, transfer, or subcontract any obligations or rights under this Agreement without prior written consent of the other party. No changes, modification, or waivers to

this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is determined to be illegal or unenforceable, that provision will be limited or eliminated to the minimum extent necessary so that this Agreement shall otherwise remain in full force and effect and enforceable. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and such counterparts together shall constitute the same instrument. This Agreement may be executed by electronic signature, which shall be considered as an original signature for all purposes and shall have the same force and effect as an original signature.

14. **Hold Harmless and Indemnification**. Buyer agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Breeder for any claims against Breeder arising from this agreement for any reason and brought by any person including Buyer. Buyer agrees to fully indemnify Breeder from any and all actions taken by Breeder to enforce this agreement or due to any failure by Buyer to adhere to the requirements and terms of the agreement including but not limited to all damages, liquidated damages, attorney fees, costs of court and any other expenses including those for Breeder repossessing the puppy/dog and getting any registration documents executed transferring ownership of the puppy/dog to Breeder.
